Social Capital Responses

•66% would stop to help if asked for directions

•17% think their neighbors would break up a fight in front of their house and someone was being beaten or threatened, but 44% are unsure

•49% are likely or very likely to organize to keep a fire station open in the area if it was threatened by cuts. **28%** are unsure

Interaction with Neighbours

69% have not attended a single CMT (community management team) meeting this year

31% attended a meeting, event, get-together or festival with other residents somewhere within this neighborhood this year

6% know their neighbors well and actively socialize, while 18% do not know anyone on their street
